2022 Chocolate Competition-Mid-Year Performance

Time: Please arrive at **8:15am**. On arrival you will pay entry fees at the door then head over to the numbers table to collect your number and pin onto the front of your child's leotard(lower belly). You will then take a seat in the auditorium and wait for your child's age group to be called backstage. There will be a drop off with our lovely IDC helpers.

Please note this will be a half day event and you will be required to stay for the duration. This is to support and watch each age group. It is looking to be a fun-filled day!

We ask that everyone arrives ready to go with hair and makeup done. Touch ups, changing into leotards can be done at the venue. But must be done in the toilet and hair to be done outside of the auditorium..

Cost: \$15.50 per student (This will be charged at the door, with spectators fees)

Spectator Fee: Children free, \$8 per adult, \$5 per concession/seniors. We will **NOT** be accepting cash on the day. We will have our square device which accepts all cards. We are asking to please cap spectators at 4-5 family members each. The auditorium seats 180, so we need to ensure there are enough seats for all. Thankyou for your understanding.

What to wear: APDA students are required to wear an APDA leotard with or without their APDA shorts/leggings.. Boys to wear their APDA dance attire. If you do not have an APDA leotard, please search "Physie & Dance JNR Leotard Sales" on Facebook and "Physie & Dance Senior Leotard Sales" and you will be able to pick up a secondhand leotard from that page.

Please let us know if you need a hand.

Hair and makeup: Please keep makeup as minimal as possible. Juniors can wear foundation, lipstick, eyeshadow, blush, and mascara. **NO** eyeliner, glitter, fake eyelashes, tan, nail polish or earrings. Please head to our website www.indooroopillydanceco.com Members area-p/w:dance2022 and under Competitions & Performances you will see a document with hairstyle examples that we have created for you.

Seniors-ladies can wear as much or as little as they wish. Fake eyelashes, tan, hair pieces, earrings(studs), nail polish etc. are accepted.

Hair is to be off the face. E.g., high pony (straight or curly pony), Ballet bun, Hair out with curls. You can also side part your child's hair in any of these styles but please let me know if you need some help. No teasing of the hair or glitter is permitted. If you get stuck, YouTube has some good tutorials. You are also welcome to have a chat with Emma or myself and we can assist you.

Seniors-ladies can have any hair style and teasing is also allowed.

Hair Bow: Children wear a matching bow to their leotard colour. There is a local lady called "Fantasnik hair bowz" who makes APDA bows for competitions. If you are interested, I can put you in touch with her, otherwise feel free to find one yourself. Please ensure that it's not a JoJo bow and doesn't have any glitter or diamantes attached to it

Students will gain a lot from our choc comp such as firsthand competition experience, stage experience, individual feedback sheet where the students can go over and know what areas to work on, chocolate, socialize with friends and other students, building self-confidence and much more!

Videoing: You can video your own child at our performance. This will be a great way for your child to watch it back and go over the feedback sheet which they will be receiving after their performance. At official APDA competitions NO videoing is allowed, so take this great opportunity. Please note, you can only video your child and no one else. Be mindful of posting your videos on social media as there are copyright laws around music etc.

We will try our very best to follow the schedule on the day and we appreciate your patience with a busy day ahead!
